



Second Call for School Council Members

Hillview Academy has **ONE** position open on our School Council for a **Community Representative**. This is an appointed position. A community representative does not need to have children enrolled in school. All interested and eligible persons will be considered for the position (see attached form). Successful candidates will be appointed by the elected members of council.

School Council members have an advisory role at Hillview Academy. The council typically gets involved in policy and issues that affect the entire student body; the scope is broadly focused. Council is not a forum for dealing with individual student and/or personal matters. Members may be involved in aspects of the School Development Plan, and other school functions (such as fundraising and school promotion).

As a member (either elected or appointed), there is a commitment to attend monthly meetings. These meetings usually happen during one evening per month (schedule depends on availability of the group and the urgency of agenda items). Each member agrees to serve one 3-year term and is eligible for a second term.

The council provides an important link between the school, parents, and community. I would strongly encourage all eligible persons, who have a strong interest in the promotion and development of Hillview Academy, to submit your name for consideration. I look forward to your response.
